Florida's outdoors offers plenty of 'things to do'

The start of the new year brings Florida's festival season with parades, arts and crafts fairs, outdoor concerts, rodeos and more! Many of these festivals celebrate the winter and spring harvests.

Florida enjoys mild weather in the winter and spring months which means Floridians and visitors can enjoy a variety of activities while outdoors. Boating, hiking, fishing, kayaking, bird watching, observing wildlife, photography, swimming, shooting sports and many other activities can be easily adapted to social distancing.

At the start of the COVID-19 pandemic, many of the traditional recreational and entertainment options in Florida were postponed or altered. As scientists learned more about the virus, and how it is transmitted, many of the original restrictions were relaxed. The wide availability of vaccines and booster shots has also made many people more comfortable enjoying community events.

Florida beaches, parks, restaurants and stores are open.

The Florida Department of Health, along with the Centers for Disease Control advises common-sense precautions to help pre-

vent the spread of the virus and keep yourself and others safe.

- Wash your hands frequently and thoroughly with soap and hot water. If you can't wash, use hand sanitizer.
- Maintain at least 6 feet of distance between yourself and those who are not in your immediate household.
- Wear a mask (surgical or N95 masks are recommended) when you cannot maintain 6 feet of distance from others.
 - Avoid crowded areas.
- Always wash your hands before touching your face.
 - Stay home if you are sick.

Freedom Ranch offers variety of activities

OKEECHOBEE — Freedom Ranch Okeechobee LLC, owned by Elton and Angela Boney, always has something going on for those looking for an outdoor activity.

On Jan. 22, they will be holding a children's woodworking day camp from 10 a.m. antil 2 p.m. The recommended ages are from 6 to 12.

On Saturday, Feb. 12, a dinner and dance fundraiser for Martha's House will be held there at 6 p.m. Jam and Biscuits live band will be playing. Tickets can be purchased online or by calling.

On March 4 and 5, they will be holding a cowboy camp for families. The participants will be able to tent camp and learn cowboy cooking and campfires. There will be demonstrations, wood crafting, Dutch oven cooking roping dummy lessons. "Like a cowboy retreat," explained Angela Boney.

On the second Wednesday of each month they will host a Florida Cracker History day camp from 10-2. The camps will entail something different each time. One may be swamp cabbage cutting, preparing and cooking. The next might be Dutch oven cooking or Cowboy Poetry. Each camp will cost \$50. They are open to all ages, but children must be accompanied by an adult.

The second annual Cracker Cowboy Heritage Festival will be held on March 6 from 10-3. The entire day is dedicated to the Florida Cracker cowboy and Florida history. Entry to the festival is free but some of the activities will have fees. Vendors can register now to take part in the festival. The fee is \$50 for a standard vendor and \$100 for food vendors. On April 9, they will be holding an Easter cowboy style celebration with the Easter Bunny, an egg hunt and a petting zoo.

Also in April, they are planning a 5K ranch run through the woods. This will be similar to a Tough Mudder event but on a smaller scale, with obstacles along the path as you run.

In addition to the specific events scheduled, the Boneys offer individual lessons on things like riding or roping or cutting swamp cabbage.

The facility is also available to rent for corporate gatherings, birthday parties, baby showers, weddings, etc.

Lake O offers fishing, boating, and wildlife tours

There's lots of opportunity for fishing and boating on Lake Okeechobee. Lake O is the second-largest freshwater lake within the continental United States, is a vast shallow lake with a surface area covering 730 square miles. "Okeechobee" comes from the Seminole words meaning "big and water."

One of the things that makes fishing on Okeechobee so special is just its sheer size. With the lake being nearly half the size of the state of Rhode Island, the ecosystem of the lake can be wide-ranging.

For those with boats there are multiple boat ramps in the area that provide access to the big lake.

•The Clif Betts Jr. Lakeside Recreation Area (once called Lock 7) at 200 SR 78 W. includes boat ramps, a fishing pier, parking areas, access to the scenic trail and restrooms.

• The Okee-Tantie Campground and Marina at 10430 SR 78 W. includes a parking area, open fields, marina and boat ramps. It also has an amphitheater.

• The Scott Driver Recreation Area at 10101 S.R. 78 W. includes an enclosed area for meetings, parking area and boat ramps. It is the Okeechobee Fishing Tournament Headquarters.

• Other locations for boaters include the Kissimmee River C-38 complex at 8400 S.W. 99th Drive.

• Platts Bluff Park at 15925 N.W. 56th St. also includes a boat ramp.

• The Nubbin Slough, Rim Canal facility at 6206 U.S. 441 S.E. includes a parking area, boat ramp, fishing area and access to the Lake Okeechobee Scenic Trail.

• Also available is the Henry Creek Boat Ramp at 10654 U.S. 98 S., which provides access to the rim canal and fishing opportunities.

• The Taylor Creek boat ramp at 700 S.E. Fourth St. is a popular area for boaters.

•The City of Clewiston public boat ramps are located on Hoover Dike road. There are four ramps and two floating docks in the lagoon on Hoover Dike Road with access to Lake Okeechobee.

•The Pahokee Marina and Campground at 190 North Lake Avenue is pet-friendly and contains a 125-site Pahokee Campground.

For those without a boat but are still eager to set out on Lake O, there are boat rentals available around the lake. The Roland & Mary Ann Martin Marina and Resort at 920 E. Del Monte Ave. Clewiston, offers boat rentals. You can choose from 14 foot V-bottom rental fishing boats, pontoon boats, or 18.6 ft Stratos bass boats. The resort also offers fishing guides to help show you the best spots on the lake to fish with some of the best and latest equipment.

For those who don't want to fish but are more interested in seeing the sights and sounds of wildlife on Lake O, consider an air boat ride. Eaglebay Adventures at 900 State Road 78 W, Okeechobee, offer air boat tours through the marshlands of Eagle-Bay to the tall Cypress trees up

The Lake Okeechobee area has a wide variety of options for those who enjoy shooting sports, with opportunities to participate in clay shoots, target competitions, cowboy action and hunting.

O.K. Corral Gun Club, 9449 N.E. 48th St., Okeechobee, has 29 shooting stations with sporting clay courses, covered 5-stand, wobble deck, covered pistol/rifle ranges, competition shooting park and even an old west street with Cowboy Action shooting. The club also hosts a steak dinner every Friday and Saturday from 5 p.m. to 9 p.m. which features live music. Throughout the year O.K. Corral will host

multiple National Sporting Clays Association registered shoots.

Center Mass Gun Range, 1934 Center St., is Okeechobee's only indoor gun range and features many climate-controlled shooting lanes. The range also features seven simulation rooms where shooters can take turns playing through several computer-generated scenarios such as a zombie apocalypse and an Old West shoot-out.

Quail Creek Plantation, 12399 N.E. 224th Street, Okeechobee, is a pristine wilderness where sportsmen revel at the sight of pointing dogs racing back and forth across expansive fields, and the suspense of walking into the feathered whirl-

wind of a rising covey. The plantation also offers sport shooting on two scenic, 14-station fully automatic clay shooting courses.

Okeechobee Shooting Sports, 7055 N.E. 48th St., has rifle and pistol ranges, with five 5-stand sporting clays fields, trap and skeet fields and shooting galleries.



It's open 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Monday, Thursday and Friday, and 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Saturday and Sunday for a daily fee of \$30 or an hourly fee of \$15.

Duck hunting, hog hunting and alligator hunting are also popular around the lake, with some hunting allowed on public land as well as hunting with permission on private property. For more on Florida hunting seasons, licenses and permits, go online to myfwc.com.

CLEWISTON — Whether visiting Hendry County for the first time or the 100th, you will not want to miss seeing a bird's eye view of the popular fishing and resort community.

Skydive Spaceland Clewiston, one of the largest skydiving operations in south Florida, has been offering skydiving at Airglades Airport in Clewiston for more than 50 years.

It offers skydiving events year-round, including the annual "Everglades Boogie," which in 2022 is scheduled for Jan. 21-23. It attracts people from all over the world.

"We bring in multiple aircraft," said Rick Hornsby, who owns Skydive Spaceland with his wife, Lisa Hornsby. "And there are representatives from many skydive companies and retailers throughout our industry who attend."

To participate in skydiving in Clewiston, one must be 18-years old and in good physical shape to participate. Tandem skydive prices start at \$179 per person and instructors are fully certified and licensed by the United States Parachute Association.

"We have our very own FAA certified mechanic on staff to maintain our aircraft and a FAA certified rigger to maintain our parachute equipment," Hornsby said. "Our company is responsible for licensing more skydivers than any other in North America."

Hornsby added that Skydive Spaceland has made numerous positive changes to its business model to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

Walk-ins are accepted at Airglades Airport during skydiving operations Thursdays through Mondays, but those with reservations have priority. It is recommended to contact Skydive Spaceland by phone or email at least 24 hours in advance to make a reservation by phone at 863-983-6151 or email at manifestFL@SkydiveSpaceland. comat least 24 hours in advance.

"The view of Lake Okeechobee from 13,000 feet is a scene like no other," Hornsby said. "Come join us for the experience of a lifetime."

Photography is a passion for many in Okeechobee



Okeechobee offers enough to keep cameras clicking all year long, whether you are into landscapes, wildlife, or shooting the stars. Take a ride out on the lake to see wading birds and alligators, drive down to the Jaycee pier — 200 SR 78, Okeechobee, open daily sunrise to sunset — for spectacular sunrises, sunsets, and shorebirds, or hike the rim trail for everything from owls to bobcats. The area offers multiple STA's including Lakeside Ranch North — County Rd 15B, half mile west of SR 710, open sunrise to sunset Friday-Monday and the recently opened South section — Highway 441, 2 ½ miles south of 15B, open sunrise to sunset Friday-Monday. White-tailed deer and otters are waiting for you at both Taylor Creek — Highway 441, 4 miles north of SR 70, open daily sunrise to sunset and Nubbin Slough — High-

way 710, 1 mile north of 15A, open daily sunrise to sunset. Other areas to explore include Grassy Island Trail — 1901 Hillard Road, Okeechobee open daily sunrise to sunset, C. Scott Driver Park — 10100 W SR78, Okeechobee open 24 hours and Okee-Tantie — 10430 W SR78, Okeechobee, open 24 hours. If you feel like venturing further out of town, Kissimmee Prairie Preserve State Park — 33104 NW 192nd Ave. Okeechobee. open daily sunrise to sunset is one of the best places in Florida to see the Milky Way. It is no wonder that nature photographers everywhere consider Okeechobee "Florida's Best Kept Secret."
