

2022 OHS graduating class is anything but normal

One would think a description like "normal" used to describe a graduating high class would sound like boring.

But for the 102nd graduating class of Okeechobee High School, the word "normal" feels like a relief.

After the previous two classes had their senior year heavily impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic, the Class of 2022 had to wonder what lay in store for them as they headed into their final year of high school.

But, thankfully, the disruptions from the last two years were few and far between. While in 2021 administrators and school staff were able to put together a homecoming bonfire experience for seniors late in the school

year as restrictions loosened up, this year the scramble wasn't necessary. Because for the most part, things were back to their normal schedule.

Homecoming, the traditional bonfire, prom, and more were all back. Things felt just a little more normal.

Some of the new traditions from the pandemic did carry over, however. In 2020, Heidi Dove-Handford helped organize an Adopt a Senior program, where members of the Okeechobee community could "adopt" one of the seniors from that year's class. The idea was to acknowledge some of the students that went through a tough final year at OHS and gift them with something nice whether that would be a gift basket college grant down room.

That program carried over to 2021 seniors the following year. And now, the Okeechobee community has kept the ball rolling into 2022, adopting seniors from this year's class and showering them with gifts and support.

While this year at OHS may have felt more normal, the accomplishments by the Brahmans this year were anything but.

The Brahmans represented Okeechobee well at competitions across the state and nation. The OHS Brahman Band finished in fifth at the Florida Marching Band Championships with a score of 80.8 for their season. That score is the highest the Brahman Band has ever achieved. Longtime

OHS Band director Clint LaFlam credited the performance to the desire students had to be back on the field after missing last year.

The OHS Jazz Band followed that up later in the school year with straight superior ratings for the first time ever.

OHS in 2022 earned district championships galore. The girls tennis team, boys baseball team, and girls basketball team all secured back-to-back district championships this year. OHS girls wrestling crowned two district champs in their first inaugural season.

Speaking of inaugural seasons, OHS fielded a girls lacrosse team this year for the first time ever. Seniors on the team have helped set a foundation for the program to build off of for years to come.

The OHS Ag Mechanics team was named state champions towards the end of the school year. And the Okeechobee FFA continued their dominance in state and national competitions.

The Class of 2022 found out they will be one of the final few classes of seniors to graduate from the old Okeechobee High School. After years of attempts, funding was finally approved by the state to construct a new high school in Okeechobee. If planning and construction goes well, the new building could be up by the 2024-25 school year.


The 102nd graduating class of OHS has helped make this year one for the history books. Now, it's up to the Class of 2023 step up and carry the torch.
